GRADUATE APPLICATION DEADLINES

This completed application and your file materials must be submitted no fewer than thirty days before the beginning of the term in which you request admission. Departments and professional schools may have earlier deadlines; please contact your department directly.

Do not use this form if you want to apply for a second bachelor's degree. Instead, request an Application for Postbaccalaureate Nongraduate Status from the Office of Admissions, 240 Oregon Hall, 1217 University of Oregon 97403-1217, (541) 346-3201 or (800)232-3825.

GRADUATE SCHOOL PROGRAMS

Admission to the Graduate School is essential for anyone seeking a graduate degree or wanting to enroll in a formal graduate program that does not lead to a degree. A student admitted conditionally will not be granted unconditional status until requirements specified by the department or the university or both have been met. A student must achieve master's or doctoral classification before a degree can be awarded.

TRANSFER CREDITS AND RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS

Subject to departmental and Graduate School approval, a limited number of University of Oregon graduate credits earned as a premaster's, postmaster's, or nondegree student may be transferred to a master's degree program. Every master's degree candidate must complete at least 30 graduate credits on the Eugene campus after achieving master's status.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

1. A bachelor's degree from an accredited four-year college or university. An applicant who attended an unaccredited institution or one offering the equivalent of bachelor's degree instruction, but not the degree itself, can petition for admission under special procedures determined by the Graduate School.
2. Acceptance by the major department or professional school of proposed study. University departments and professional schools determine their own requirements for both conditional and unconditional admission.
3. Approval of the dean of the Graduate School.

APPLICATION SUBMISSION PROCEDURES

1. Submit both page 1 and page 2 of this application, a \$50 (U.S.) nonrefundable application fee, and official transcripts (except University of Oregon) showing all degrees earned to:

By signing the application, you give your permission for the use of your SSN to assist the UO and the OUS (and organizations conducting studies for or on behalf of the OUS) in developing, validating, or administering predictive tests and assessments; administering student aid programs; improving instruction; identifying students internally; collecting student debts; or comparing student educational experiences with subsequent work-force experiences. When conducting studies, the UO and the OUS will disclose your SSN only in a manner that does not permit personal identification of you by individuals other than representatives of the UO and the OUS (or the organization conducting the study for the OUS) and only if the information is destroyed when no longer needed for the purposes for which the study was conducted. By providing your social security number, you are consenting to the uses identified above. This request is made pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes 351.070 and 351.085. You are not required to consent to the use of your SSN for research; if you choose not to do so, you will not be denied any right, benefit, or privilege provided by law. You may revoke your consent for the use of your SSN at any time by writing to the Office of Admissions. If you do not give consent to use your SSN for research, please attach a note requesting a system-generated number.
