


2022 Admissions Cycle Wrap-Up

2022 Admissions Cycle Wrap-Up

- Incoming students with outstanding requirements:
- **Final transcripts:** students admitted pending conferral of degree must submit final transcripts. Reminders will be sent to students and programs.
- **Credential Exceptions:** we will work individually with students admitted pending the review of their original documents.

Teaching GE Language Requirement

- Non-native English speaking teaching GEs must provide one of the following:
 - Test of Spoken English (TSE): Min. score: 50
 - Internet-based (iBT) TOEFL Speaking: Min. score: 26
 - IELTS Academic Module Speaking Band: Min. Score: 7
 - SPEAK Test (offered by UO in September): Min. score: 50

Master's Graduation Process

- Summer Statement of Completion deadline: September 20th (submit in GradWeb)
- Do not submit Statements of Completion until all department requirements have been met (grades are in, terminal projects approved, required Incompletes resolved, etc.)

Doctoral Graduation Processes

Reminder: the following changes were effective Fall 2021:

New deadlines

- Apply for oral defense: 2 weeks prior to defense date
 - Expectation remains that the student provide a draft to the committee at least 3 weeks prior
- Submit dissertation to Graduate School: 2 weeks after defense date

New approval processes

- Grad Coordinator can simply approve the defense in GradWeb; PDF copy no longer required to be sent to GS
- Post-defense committee approvals: Faculty will log in to GradWeb to provide their approvals
- Department approval: Grad coordinator will submit Statement of Completion in GradWeb (will mirror master's process)
- No Certificate of Completion or physical signatures required

Doctoral Graduation Processes

Reminder: Remote Defense Policy – effective Fall 2021

- It is permissible for the student and/or committee members to participate remotely, provided the conditions below are met:
 - a) Advance agreement of the student and all committee members has been obtained;
 - b) All participants must join in with two-way audio and video connections;
 - c) Any visual aids or other materials must have been distributed in advance to the remote participants;
 - d) The committee members must participate in the complete meeting, discussion, presentation, and evaluation; and
 - e) The student is responsible for making technological and logistical arrangements.

Policy Changes

MA Language - New policy effective Fall 2023:

- There is no university-wide language requirement for master's degrees. Departments and programs have the option of requiring or not requiring one or more languages other than English (LOTE). If one or more languages are required, the degree-granting unit is responsible for monitoring and enforcing that requirement.
- Each program should decide what their language requirement will be
- Any changes to current requirements must be vetted by the department/program following its normal curricular procedures
- We will send Qualtrics survey to gather each program's requirements (full UO curricular review not required for changes to MA language req's)

Generic Courses – New Numbering

Goal is more logical groupings of similar types of activities:

- 601 Research
- 602 Supervised College Teaching
- 603 Dissertation
- 604, 704 Internship
- 605, 705 Reading & Conference or Special Problems
- 606, 706 Practicum or Field Studies or Special Problems
- 607, 707 Seminar or Colloquium
- 608, 708 Workshop or Laboratory Projects or Colloquium
- 609, 709 Practicum or Supervised Tutoring or Terminal Project or Capstone

Summer Support for International Students

- International students who had a GE appointment during AY 2021-22 as part of a multi-year funding offer commitment and do not have a GE appointment in the summer of 2022 may apply to the Graduate Student Assistance Fund for up to \$500 to support summer living expenses.
- If funding is available, students may apply for another \$500 after August 15th (funding is still available!)
